A. water Quality & Monitoring (Mandatory)
 □ pH 7.20–8.00 (tested at least 3× daily) □ Free chlorine within required levels (checked morning, midday, afternoon; one test at peak used water clarity: Secchi disc visible at 10 m □ Total alkalinity 80–120 mg/L □ Continuous water renewal during operation □ Full renewal within required time (existing pools: ≤4 hours) □ Monthly microbiological testing by accredited lab □ If microbiological limits exceeded → take corrective action & notify competent authority
B. Recirculation & Filtration System (Mandatory)
 □ Recirculation system runs during entire operation □ Pumps (active + standby 50% capacity) □ Filters meet required filtration rate □ Flow meters and pressure gauges installed and accessible □ Annual hydraulic performance test by Mechanical Engineer □ Proper backwashing procedures followed and recorded
C. Disinfection & Chemicals (Mandatory)
 □ Continuous disinfection (chlorine or approved alternative) □ Cyanuric acid ≤100 mg/L (if used) □ Disinfection records logged daily (Second Schedule format) □ Chemicals stored in dry, ventilated, separate area □ Automatic dosing recommended (mandatory if >200 m³)
D. Responsible Pool Operator (Mandatory)
 □ Operator appointed in writing (Third Schedule form) □ Minimum qualifications: age ≥21, secondary education, clean criminal record □ First aid + health certificate (optional for Type 3) □ Operator duties performed:
■ Monitoring chlorine & pH
□ Conducting/arranging testing
Maintaining logbook
□ Ensuring safe operation & signage
Monitoring bather numbers
E. Cleanliness & Hygiene (Mandatory if facilities exist)
